- Connection to project preparation facilities (PPFs), potential investors and strategic global and regional initiatives and platforms that offer technical assistance

STEP 1: APPLY TO THE TAP

- Project screening - basic quality assurance
- Evaluation of completeness
- Evaluation of transformative approach



OUTCOMES

- Well defined transformative action
- Project improvement feedback

STEP 2: GAIN TAP APPROVAL

- Receive the TAP seal of approval from the ICLEI World Secretariat to access TAP services



OUTCOMES

- TAP projects gain access to selected services

STEP 3: ACCESS SERVICES

ACCESS IMPLEMENTATION AND FINANCE SUPPORT

TAP projects bearing the TAP seal can be selected for capacity building and technical assistance. They also gain access to investors, PPFs and financial service providers.
